What's included?

Standard listings include your position published on the ALIA Job Vacancies page of our website (www.alia.org.au/jobs), which is available to all Members of ALIA, until the closing date of the position's applications. The position will also be included in our recruitment enewsletter, RecruitLIS, with new positions featured and separated by state or on a national or international basis. RecruitLIS has 4,500 active subscribers.

Featured listings

In addition to a standard listing, featured listings can be purchased to highlight your position in ALIA Weekly, our enewsletter which goes out to a list of over 10,000 subscribers in the library and information sector. Featured listings have an additional cost of \$110 per week and allow you to choose which editions of ALIA Weekly the position will be highlighted.
