VISIT OF THE PRIME MINISTER OF AUSTRALIA
ON JULY 2ND, 1918.

Attached hereto is a provisional programme of arrangements to enable the Honorable the Prime Minister of AUSTRALIA to see as many as possible of the Troops of the Australian Corps during Tuesday, July 2nd.

In the time-table, the second clock time named at each place is the time at which the visiting party must leave that place, in order to arrive at the next locality by the time stated.

At each locality, the Troops are to be assembled in as compact a formation as circumstances permit, to enable the Prime Minister to address them if he so desires.- No time will be available to alter the formation after the arrival of the party.

The Senior Officer at each locality will be presented to the Prime Minister and will then present only his most senior officers, as time will not permit of junior officers being presented.

The assembly of Troops at each locality is not to be confined to the Unit named in the tabulation- Representatives of any other units which are billeted or located within easy walking reach of each locality are also to be assembled, by the Senior Officer, at the locality named.

In every case, wherever possible, the Troops are to be assembled under cover of woods or trees, so as to reduce the risk of enemy observation from the air.

The aim should be to have representative parades rather than full parades, not more than 1000 men to be assembled at any one spot.

Order of dress, turn out, and formation to be adopted are left to the discretion of the Senior Officer at each locality.

The A.D.C. to the Corps Commander will visit Commanders to arrange all other details.

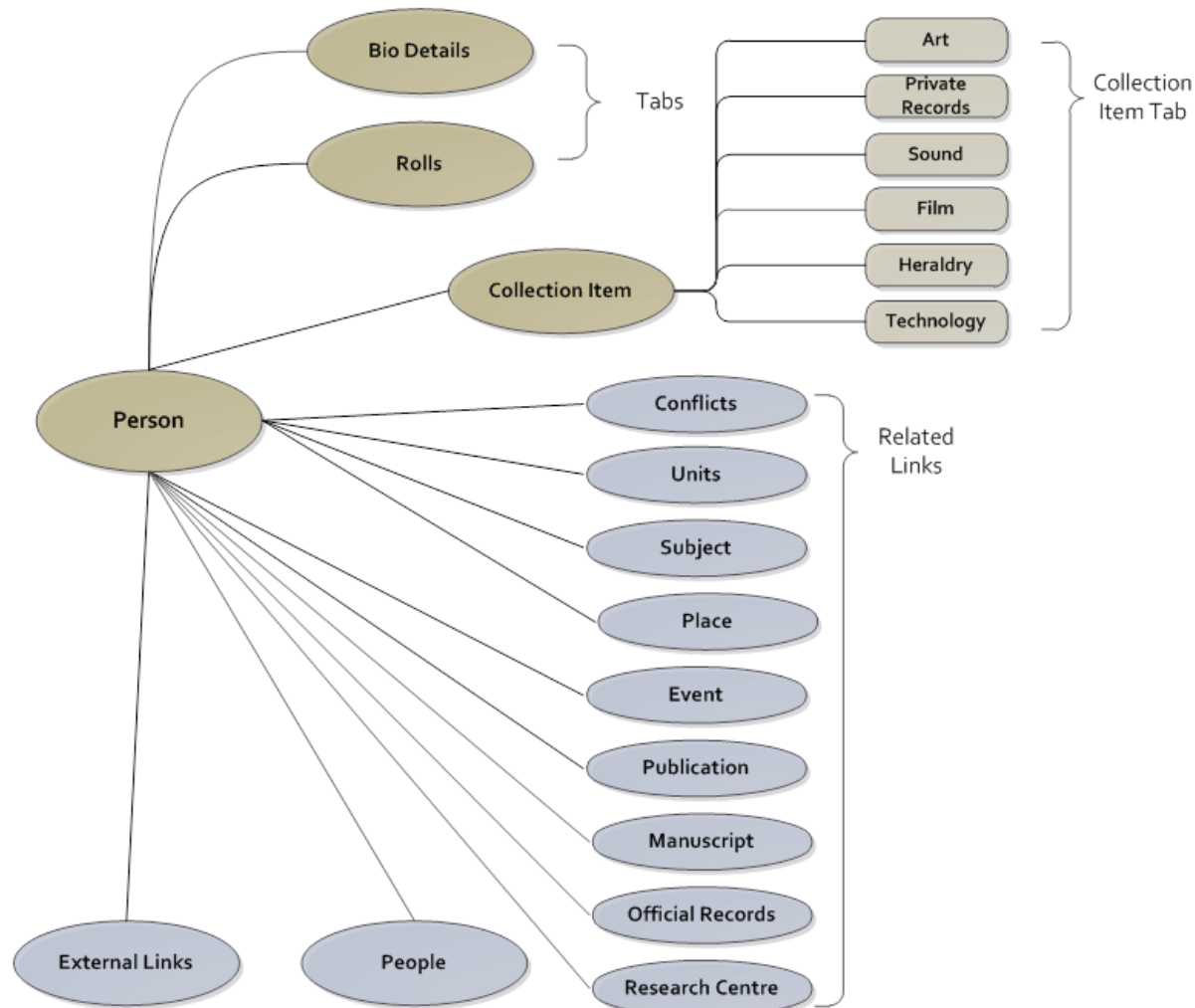

John Monash is considered one of the war's outstanding commanders. Monash was born in Melbourne on 27 June 1865. He was dux of Scotch College and studied arts and engineering at Melbourne University, where he was also involved in debating and student politics. Outside of university he dabbled in acting. In 1884 he joined the university company of the 4th Battalion, Victorian Rifles.

Monash was a driven young man, ambitious and intelligent. He worked on the construction of the Princes Bridge in Melbourne and in 1888 was placed in charge of constructing a new railway even though he had yet to complete his degree. Monash married Hannah Moss in April 1891, finished his studies in 1895 and, having long since decided to combine engineering with a military career, was promoted to captain in the Garrison Artillery that year. In 1897 Monash was promoted to major in the North Melbourne Battery and served

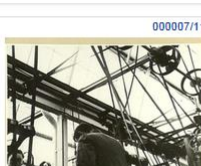
